## TERM 2 UPDATE

Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you to the families who responded to the letter regarding attendance for next week (Week 1 of Term 2).

We respect the preferences of parents and will continue to work with all families to ensure the best outcomes for students. If you have decided to keep your children at home for the commencement of Term 2 and then after Week 1 decide that you want your child/ren at school, please notify the Front Office on the day prior to your child/ren returning.

### General information

- School buses will run as normal every morning. If there are no students for the afternoon run, the route will not operate.
- All students need to bring a named full water bottle to school. Students can refill these throughout the day.
- Health advice from the Department for Education is that students are allowed to play on the school playgrounds. The playgrounds are not open to the public.
- Hand sanitiser and/or soap is available in all learning spaces.
- Tissues are available in all learning spaces.
- Lunch orders will continue on Mondays and Thursdays (Ardrossan Bakery).
- We will not be conducting any excursions (Year 10 Business Innovation will continue to operate via Teams) or assemblies until further notice.

### Week 1

- The teaching and learning program will be as prepared by the staff over the last few weeks. It will be a combination of digital and face to face learning.
- The On-line video conference times may vary from the original timetables. Teachers will notify students via Teams/Class Dojo updated times.

### Procedures for Monday 27<sup>th</sup> April


#### Students on site

- Parents/carers are asked not to enter the school yard. Staff will be on duty to supervise students from 8.35am.
- All students are to go to their Home group classroom at 8.50am.
- There will be an extended Morning Home Group until 9.10am. During this time, rolls will be taken and Home Group teachers will communicate to students the timetable for the day.
- During Home Group, hygiene practices and social distancing behaviours will be reinforced.

#### Students learning at home

- As previously advised, Reception – Year 3 students need to check in on Class Dojo for Home Group between 8.30am-9am (Attendance recorded).
- As previously advised, Year 4/5 – Year 12 students need to check into their Home Group Team by 9am (attendance recorded).



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- Students will work on the program provided by teachers via Class Dojo (Reception – Year 3) and Teams (Year 4-12). Teachers will notify students of video conference times via a message on Teams/Class Dojo.

Again, I thank our school community for your support. We have endeavoured to put plans in place to best support all students. Please understand that these plans are flexible and will evolve as we receive further information and attendance numbers vary.
